

Gentle hints

Read only as much help as you need. The numbered hints progress through the evidence chain; they do not necessarily match the verdict question numbers.

Hint 1

Identity: compare left with right, not just the existence of a repair.

Hint 2

Parcel: add every packaging component once.

Hint 3

Destination: place North first, then try the two possible consecutive South/East pairs.

Hint 4

Culprit: the destination label is stronger evidence than someone expressing interest in the shirt.

Hint 5

Recovery: a hold instruction does not replace the original route used for shelving.

Stronger hints

Read only as much help as you need. The numbered hints progress through the evidence chain; they do not necessarily match the verdict question numbers.

Hint 1

Only Y matches both the left-hem repair and right-cuff nick, with the two collar holes.

Hint 2

Packaging totals 136 g. The original makes a 300 g parcel.

Hint 3

M1 is North. South/East cannot be M3/M4 because that would leave West at M2.

Hint 4

The original is in M2. Read the label number on M2 and identify its supervised recipient.

Hint 5

Combine route S with the 290-309 g band. LQ-9 also identifies who would receive the \$9,000.
